Pilot Requirements

- FAA Private Pilot Certificate
- FAA Medical – Current Third Class or higher
- (Must be current for the duration of your training and at the time of your FAA Flight Test)
- Must have 50 Hours of cross country as PIC at the time of your flight test.*
- (Note: 15 hours of cross country is included in this course)
- ***Block Rates are available if additional PIC Cross Country hours are needed to meet the 50 hour requirement.**
